Visitors will be educated about vaulting when they enter the arenas to watch practice on the horse and barrel competition. All will be given a competition schedule and invited to return to watch male and female athletes of all ages from beginners to champions compete on a wide range of horses from thoroughbreds to draft breeds at the 2005 USEF/AVA National Vaulting Championships.
